

REVISION OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION (NSF) Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR)/Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) Phase II Grant General Conditions (SBIR-II)

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016

Effective July 1, 2016, all new NSF Phase II SBIR/STTR grants and funding amendments, will incorporate by reference the *Small Business Innovation Research/Small Business Technology Transfer Phase II Grant General Conditions* (SBIR-II) dated 07/01/16.

Unless otherwise noted in a specific article, the <u>SBIR Phase II Grant General Conditions</u> apply to all new NSF Phase II SBIR/STTR grants and funding amendments to existing NSF SBIR/STTR grants awarded on or after July 1, 2016.

A comprehensive summary of the changes is included below. Any questions regarding these changes may be directed to the cognizant SBIR/STTR Program Director.

Significant Changes to the NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II Grant General Conditions, dated 07/16

- **Prior Approval Requirements, Article 3,** contains a new requirement that written approval (e.g. via email) is required from the cognizant NSF Program Director for any project revision that results in a 5% or greater budget reallocation.
- Payments, Article 13, contains a new requirement that all SBIR Phase II awardees
 must request payments electronically through NSF's Award Cash Management Service
 (ACM\$).

<u>Clarifications and Other Changes to the NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II Grant General</u> Conditions, dated 07/16

- Grantee Responsibilities and Federal Requirements, Article 2, has been supplemented with language regarding the Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR).
- **No-Cost Extensions**, **Article 5**, has been updated to describe the revised procedures for submitting no-cost extension requests.
- **Project Reporting Requirements, Article 14,** clarifies the timing of interim reports and the information that is required.
- Recipient Integrity and Performance Matters, Article 39, is an entirely new Article
 which implements the requirements stipulated in Appendix XII to Part 200 of 2 CFR §
 200.
